July-Dec 2021 PHASE 1 Phase 1: Exploration

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We are currently engaging in:

Leading to the creation of the Digital Social Impact Best Practice Audit, a report derived from academics in European HEIs on digital teaching formats which aim to create societal impact

Dec-May 2022 PHASE 2 Phase 2: Development

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We will be working on:

- Technical Specifications
- Content Development
- Technological Development

Leading to the creation of the Digital Social Impact Course Toolkit – a collection of HEI led teaching approaches, activities, and topics which educators can use to achieve societal impact

Jun – Nov 2022 PHASE 3 Phase 3: Implementation and Refinement

- Collaborating with real-world social organizations
- Refinement and iterative improvements

Leading to the creation of the Digital Social Impact Course Configurator – a custom digital tool which enables HEI educators to design a tailored Digital Social Impact Course using their preferred teaching approaches, activities, and topics which educators can use to achieve societal impact

Dec 2021 – May 2022 PHASE 4Phase 4: Continuation

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We will create lasting impact by:

- Publishing course templates
- Providing hands on guidelines and workshop resources
- Widely disseminating our resources and our learning

Our final resource pack will provide Guidelines for Digital Social Impact Scaling Workshops which will attract and enable more academics to use the configurator and scale the project on the European level.
